- The ad hoc Oakland Broadband and Technology Committee has launched. Its mission is to map and analyze Oakland's current broadband assets and identify models to extend broadband access to Main Street.

- Suggested edits:
  - o Add supplementary information (e.g. list of summer camps)
  - o Add section on renewable energy in Public Facilities section
  - o Reframe phrases to begin positively (e.g. "Population" introduction)
  - Add feature on Messalonskee High's new track economic development and health/wellness opportunities
  - o Bring attention to sustainable land use tools using an incremental approach.
    - CMGC will draft a section for a small committee review
